Let's start with the specifics



- 1. After we connect, the consignment checklist will be completed by the seller, completing all necessary details in order to start the research process (measurements, provenance, etc...).
- 2. Once the completed checklist is returned, we start the

research process to determine a realistic and fair reserve price for your art. * The consultation fee is due prior to the research necessary for the reserve price. See the final page for details.

3. Once the research process is completed, the seller is contacted with a suggested reserve price. If a price is agreed upon, payment details are discussed and finalized with the seller.

The selling agreement will be drawn up and signed by the seller to consign their work with Acquisitions of Fine Art.

Detailed photographs and descriptions are the key to a successful sale.
